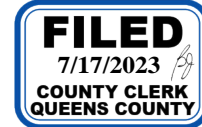

**CLASS SETTLEMENT DISTRIBUTION ORDER**

Lead Plaintiffs<sup>1</sup>, having filed an Unopposed Motion to Approve Distribution of Net Settlement Fund to Authorized Claimants, this Court, having considered all the papers filed in connection therewith, and based upon all other prior proceedings had herein, and good cause appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The proposed final Plan of Distribution (“Distribution Plan”) recommended by the Court-appointed claims administration firm in this matter, Analytics Consulting LLC (“Analytics”), as set forth at ¶44 of the Affidavit of Kari Schmidt in Support of Lead Plaintiffs’ Unopposed Motion to Approve Distribution of Net Settlement Fund to Authorized Claimants, dated May 26, 2023 (the “Schmidt Distribution Aff.”), is approved as fair and reasonable;
2. Analytics’ administrative determinations accepting (a) the “Timely Eligible Claims” as set forth in Exhibit D of the Schmidt Distribution Aff., and (b) the additional “Late But Otherwise Eligible Claims” received through and including April 30, 2023 as set forth in Exhibit E of the Schmidt Distribution Aff., are approved, and such claims are accepted;

3. The administrative determinations of Analytics rejecting all other claims, as set forth on Exhibit F to the Schmidt Distribution Aff., are approved, and such claims are rejected;

4. Any claims received after April 30, 2023 are, and shall be, rejected, except to the extent as may be permitted pursuant to the sub-section of the Distribution Plan set forth at ¶44(f) of the Schmidt Distribution Aff.;

5. The Court approves the invoice submitted by Analytics attached at Exhibit G of the Schmidt Distribution Aff. and, consistent with ¶¶1.32, 3.2, and 4.1 of the Stipulation of Settlement, directs Defendant Altice USA to promptly pay Analytics the further sum of \$113,050.60 for Analytics' fees and expenses incurred (and yet to be incurred) since January 19, 2022, for services performed, and to be performed, by it in connection with administering the Settlement and actually distributing the Net Settlement Fund to Class Members;

6. The Net Settlement Fund (after deductions of all authorized or previously allowed payments under prior orders of the Court) shall be distributed in accordance with the Distribution Plan to the accepted Claimants listed on Exhibits D and E to the Schmidt Distribution Aff.

7. Checks to be distributed to the accepted Claimants shall bear the notation "DEPOSIT PROMPTLY; VOID AND SUBJECT TO RE-DISTRIBUTION IF NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS." Analytics is authorized to take appropriate actions to locate and/or contact any eligible Claimant who has not cashed his, her, or its distribution within said time;

8. If there is any balance remaining in the Net Settlement Fund after six months after the Initial Distribution (whether by reason of tax refunds, uncashed checks, or otherwise), then (1) if Analytics and Lead Counsel determine that it is economically reasonable and cost-effective to do so, pursuant to the Distribution Plan Analytics will conduct a second distribution and, if necessary, third distribution, of the Net Settlement Fund (each an "Additional Distribution") and (2), after the Initial Distribution and any Additional Distributions are completed, any remaining

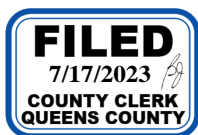
balance shall be distributed to Legal Aid Society of New York, a §501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, as provided in ¶7.8 of the Stipulation;


9. All persons involved in the review, verification, calculation, tabulation, or any other aspect of the processing of the claims submitted in this matter, or otherwise involved in the administration of the Settlement Fund, including all Plaintiffs' Counsel and Analytics, are hereby released and discharged from any and all claims arising out of such involvement, and all Class Members, whether or not they are to receive payment from the Settlement Fund, are barred from making any further claim against the Settlement Fund or any of the Released Persons beyond the amount allocated to them pursuant to this Order;

10. One year after all funds have been distributed, Analytics is hereby authorized to destroy all paper copies of Claims and supporting documentation one year after the Initial Distribution, and to destroy all electronic copies of Claims and supporting documentation one year after all settlement funds have been distributed.

11. This Court retains jurisdiction over any further application or matter which may arise in connection with this matter.
